


Table and Chart showing the number and frequency of persons injured on State basis in the month under review with FCT recording 247 injured persons.

DATA COLLECTION

The word "data" originated from Latin. It is the plural of the word "datum": which is itself derived from the root "dare", i.e. something that is given. Stated in other words, Data collection is the systematic approach to gathering and measuring information from a variety of sources to get a complete and accurate picture of an area of interest.

Data collection enables a person or organization to answer relevant questions, evaluate outcomes and make prediction about future probabilities and trends.

NATIONAL SECURITY





National security is a collective term for the defense and foreign relations of a country, protection of the interests of a country.

A broader concept of National Security is that a government should protect the state and its citizens, against all kind of "national" crises, through a variety of power projections, such as political power, diplomacy, economic power, military might, and so on.



Understanding of the concept of data is necessary, especially in the context of an ever increasingly complex world with its corresponding need for evidence based decision- making and management of human activities. Data analysis enable breakdown of complex problems into manageable units by consideration of basic factual details. Data processed yield a wealth of information upon which sound decisions and problem solving actions may be based.






A processed data for decision making


Flow of data collection, processed and usage



















BIG DATA






HARNESSING FRSC DATA FOR NATIONAL SECURITY

Crimes are committed by people hence, information that could be gathered in combating crime in the society must be harnessed.

The data gathering, processing and dissemination are relevant to National Security



Data is important in national defense and security. Our society is suspicious of intrusions on personal liberties. Data on identity cards, vehicle data, occupants and destination are crucial in securing a nation.


In recent actions in the War on Terror, intelligence analysis from data gathering has played a critical role in both offensive and defensive operations. It is important to collect, decipher, package, prioritize, disseminate, and act upon everything from the vehicle, identity of the actors, and the route analysis. Transport is very critical to National Security, crimes are accessed with motorised or non-motorised vehicles which aid the movement of the perpetrators in getting in and out of the scenes.

In as mush as transportation is important, proper identification of vehicles, the owners as well as the occupants are relevant data for detection and prevention of crime. Therefore, FRSC Data is critical to National Security



The NULS products enable biometric data which authenticate the unique human features such as finger prints, eyes, the face, signatures etc for the purpose of recognizing and verifying peoples identity. The efficacy of data collected through biometrics is a major determinant in unveiling the true identities of criminals.

These products were introduced to create a reliable database and also ensure national security. The new robust and comprehensive database will ensure that crimes committed with vehicles can be tracked, insiders abuses are curbed, revenue losses are eliminated and, the integrity of the scheme enhanced





Free flow of traffic guarantee serenity, devoid of crime while traffic congestion/hold-up enhance crime activities. One of the mandate of the Corps is to clear obstructions and ensure free flow of traffic, thereby preventing crime. Traffic volume data assist in traffic management and invariably has influence on National Security






The Nations security can not be separated from the movement of the people. The pattern and direction of movement is critical. FRSC is one of the first and regular contacts on the Road among other security operatives . The Corps often detects and reports crimes before they actually happen. eg the recent discovery of arms in a crash vehicle in Kaduna State by FRSC Patrol team. Child trafficking and large quantities of cannabis were also discovered by other teams.

The activities at the parks/terminals are constantly monitored through the passengers manifest and regular public enlightenment.

Vehicles owned by individuals captured on the database, could serve as intelligent reports on money laundering and individuals living above their means and whose activities are potent danger to National Security



FRSC collaborates with relevant agencies in the areas of crash data sharing, data on suspected stolen vehicles and drivers through the driver's license and vehicle registration.




PROTECTION OF DATA, FACILITY AND PERSONNEL
