### About Nigeria's accession to the United Nations road safety Conventions

On 18 October 2018, Nigeria acceded to the following agreements:

- ❑ 1968 convention on road traffic (enters into force 18 October 2019);
- ❑ 1958 agreement concerning the adoption of harmonized technical united nations regulations for wheeled vehicles, equipment and parts which can be fitted and/or be used on wheeled vehicles and the conditions for reciprocal recognition of approvals granted on the basis of these united nations regulations (enters into force 17 December 2018);
- ❑ 1997 agreement concerning the adoption of uniform conditions for periodical technical inspections of wheeled vehicles (enters into force 17 December 2018);
- ❑ 1998 agreement concerning the establishing of global technical regulations for wheeled vehicles, equipment and parts (enters into force 17 December 2018);
- ❑ 1957 agreement concerning the international carriage of dangerous goods by road (ADR) (enters into force 18 November 2018).

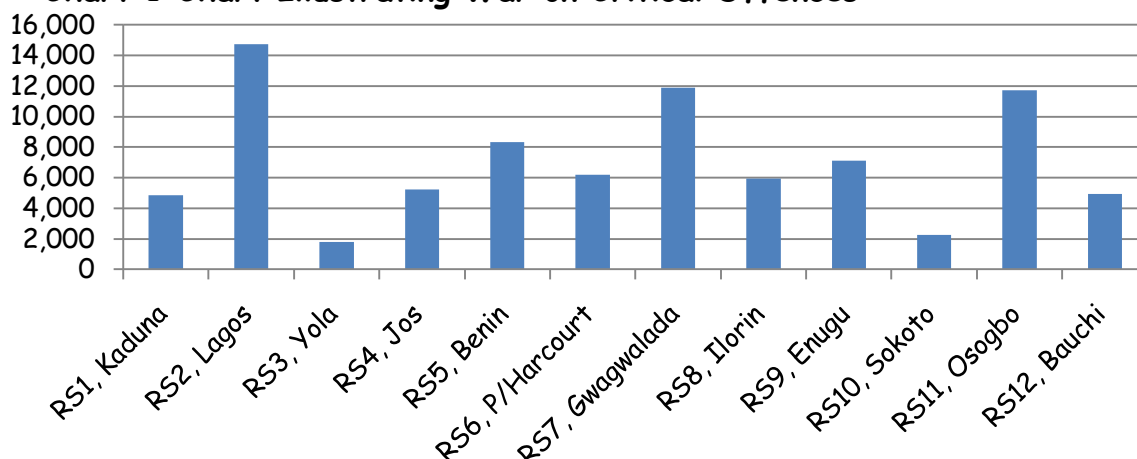

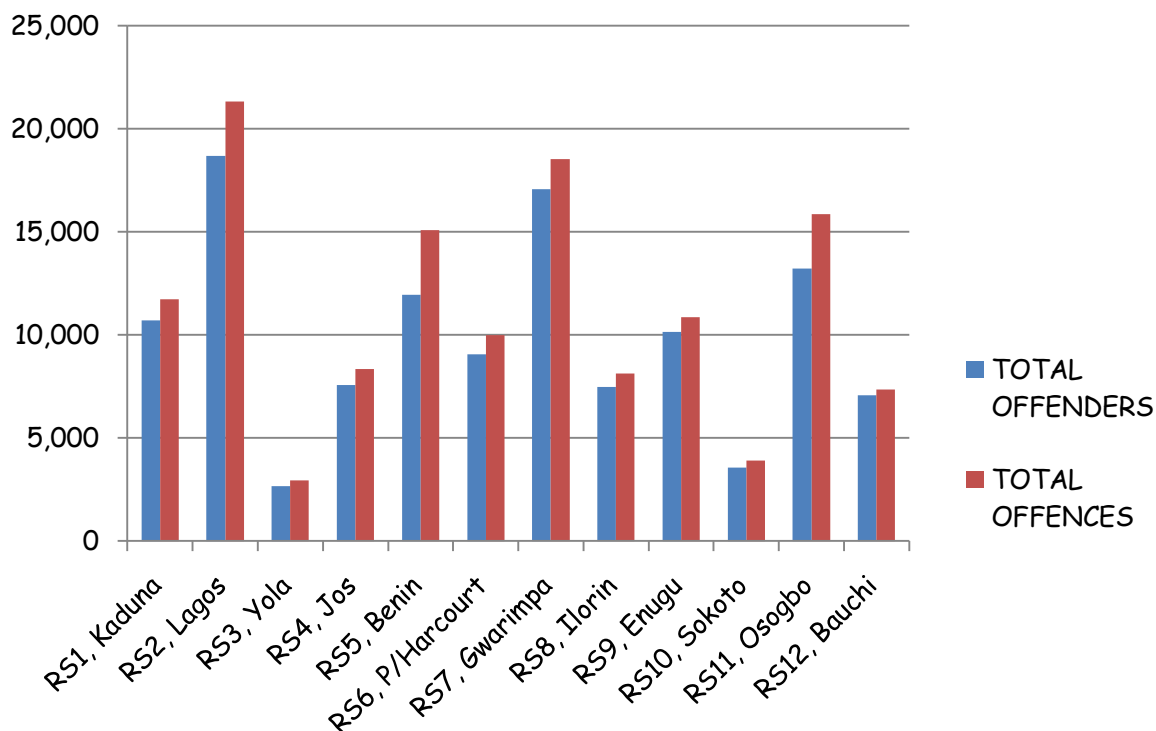
**Chart 1: Chart Illustrating War on Critical Offences**

**Chart 2: Chart Illustrating Offenders/Offences**



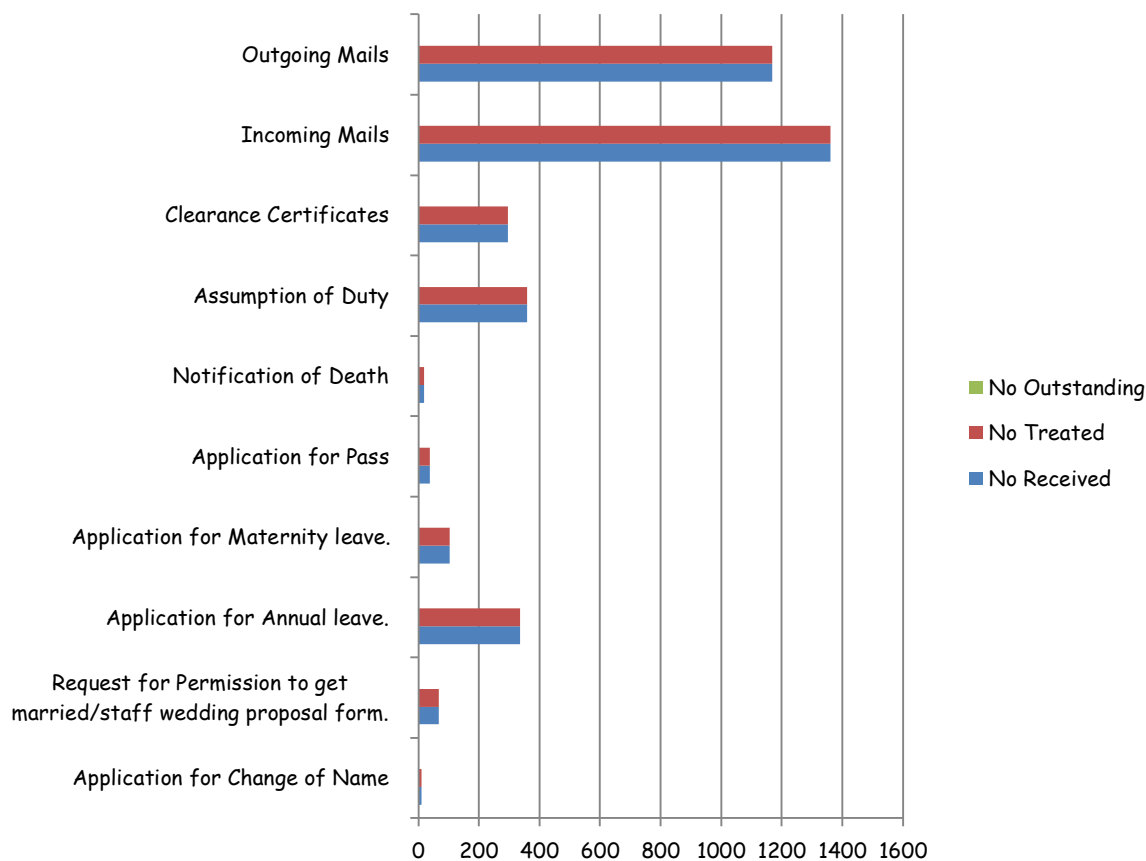

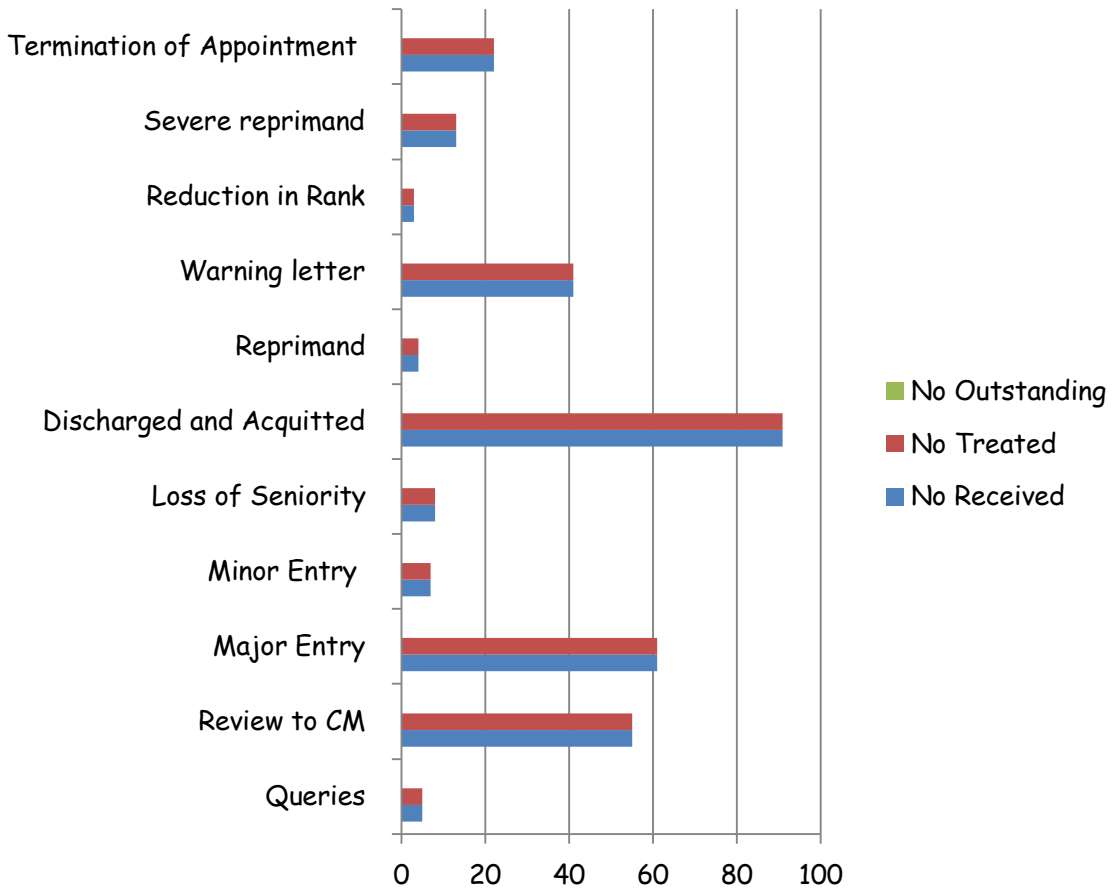
**Chart 3: General Admin Activities**

**Chart 4: Chart Illustrating Disciplinary Cases Treated**



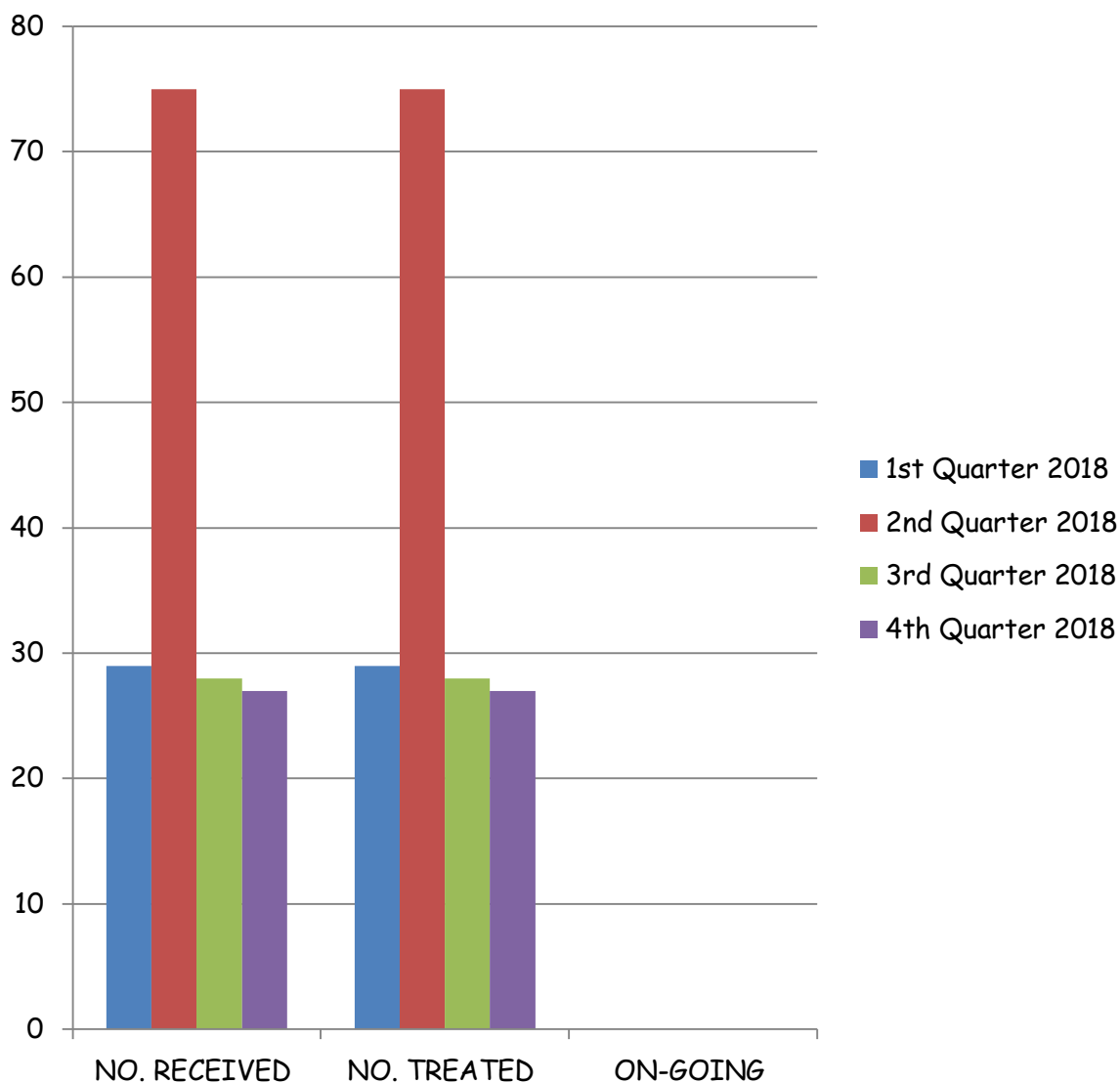

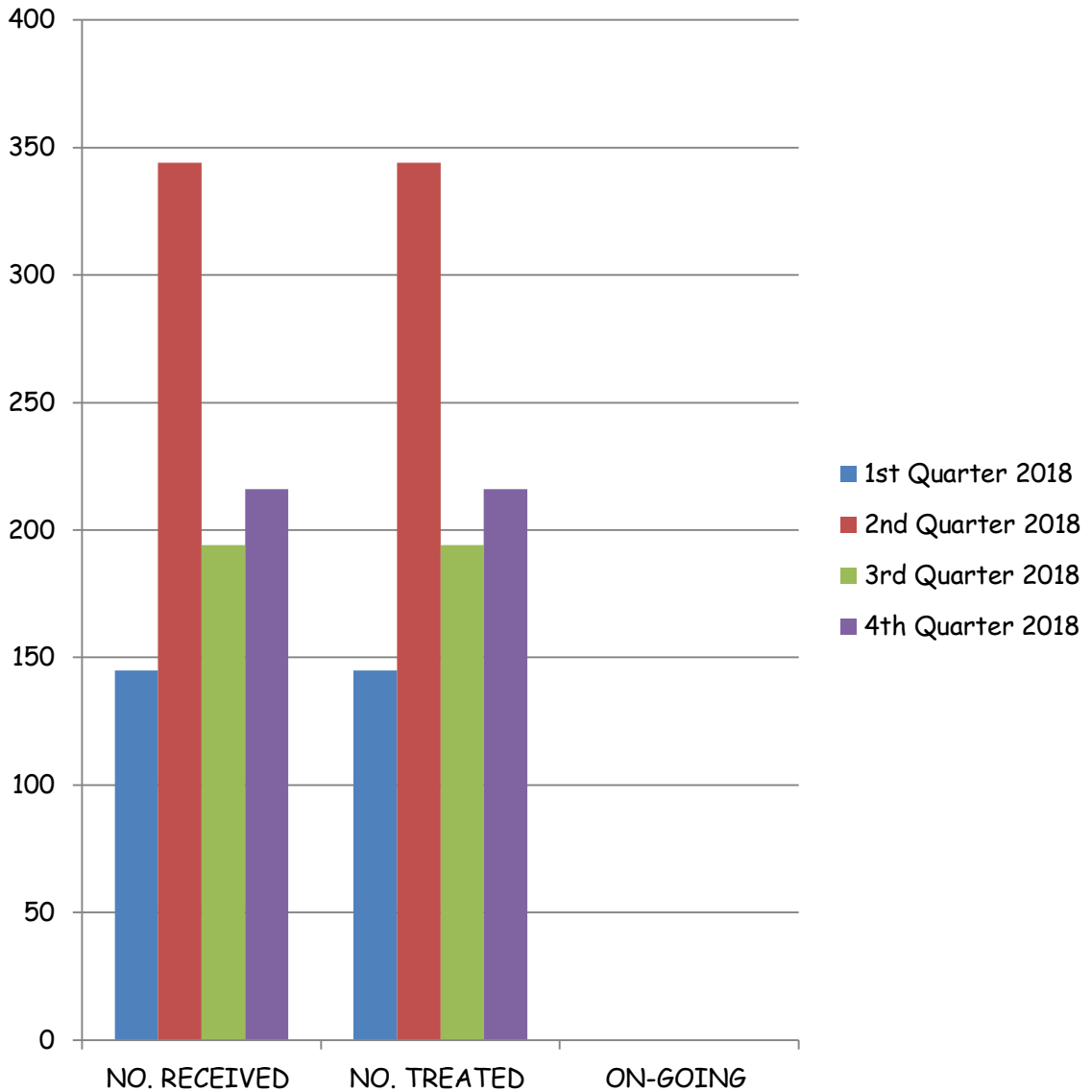
**Chart 5: Chart Illustrating Requests For Variation Of Staff Salaries (Officers)**

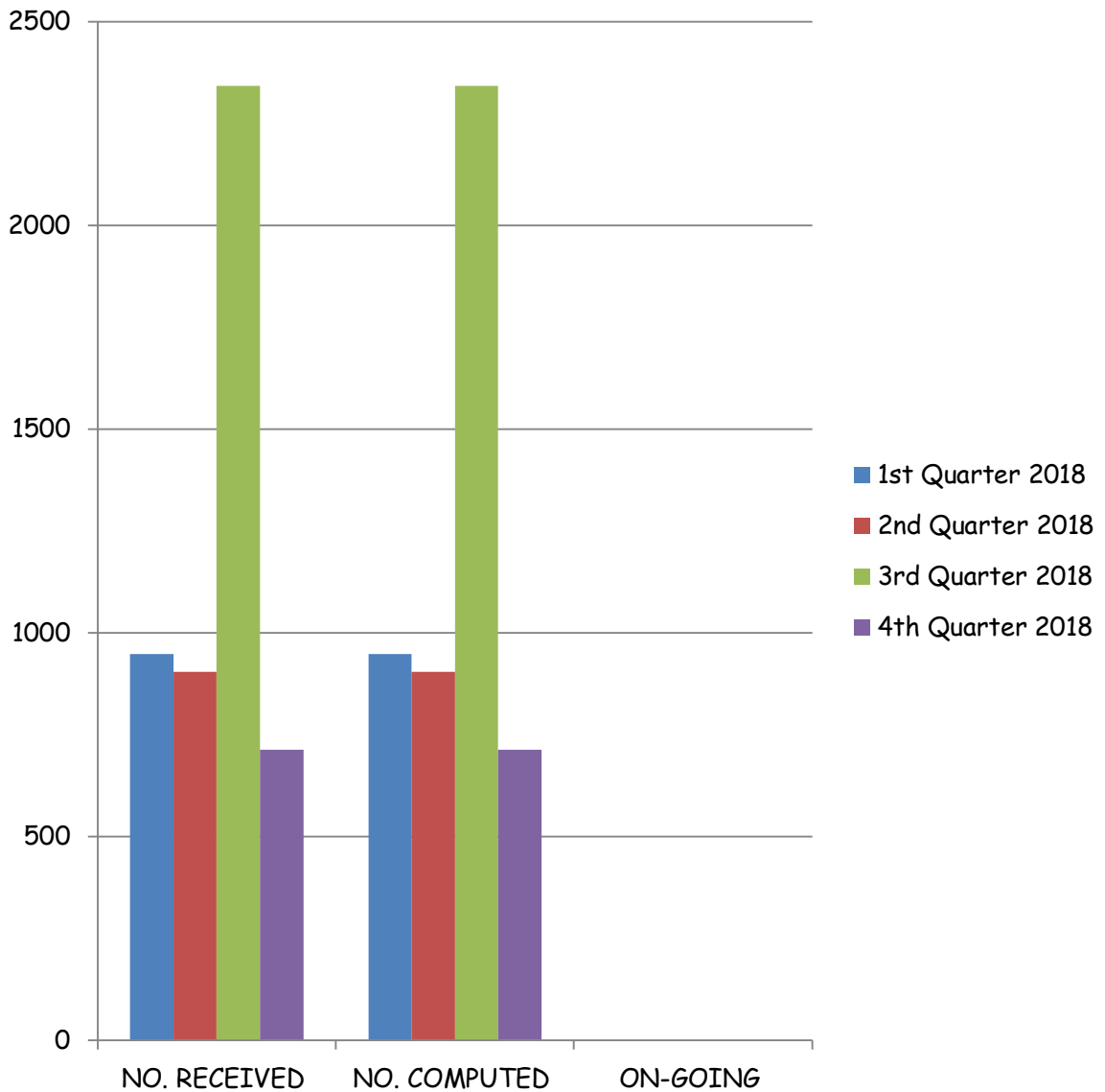
**Chart 6: Incoming Requests For Variation Of Staff Salaries (Marshals)**

**Chart 7: Summary of Transfer Allowances Activities**



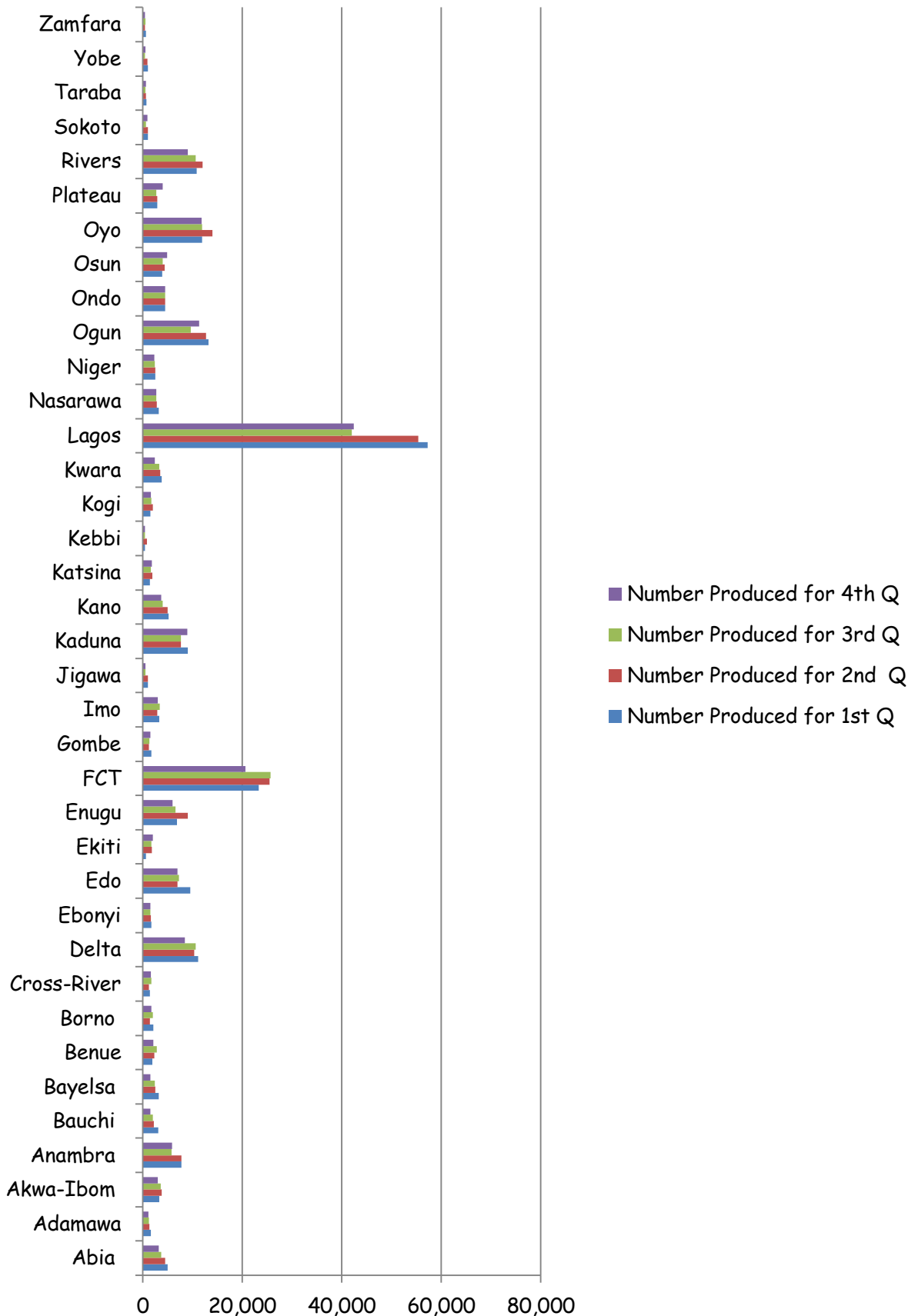

**Chart 8: National Driver License production**

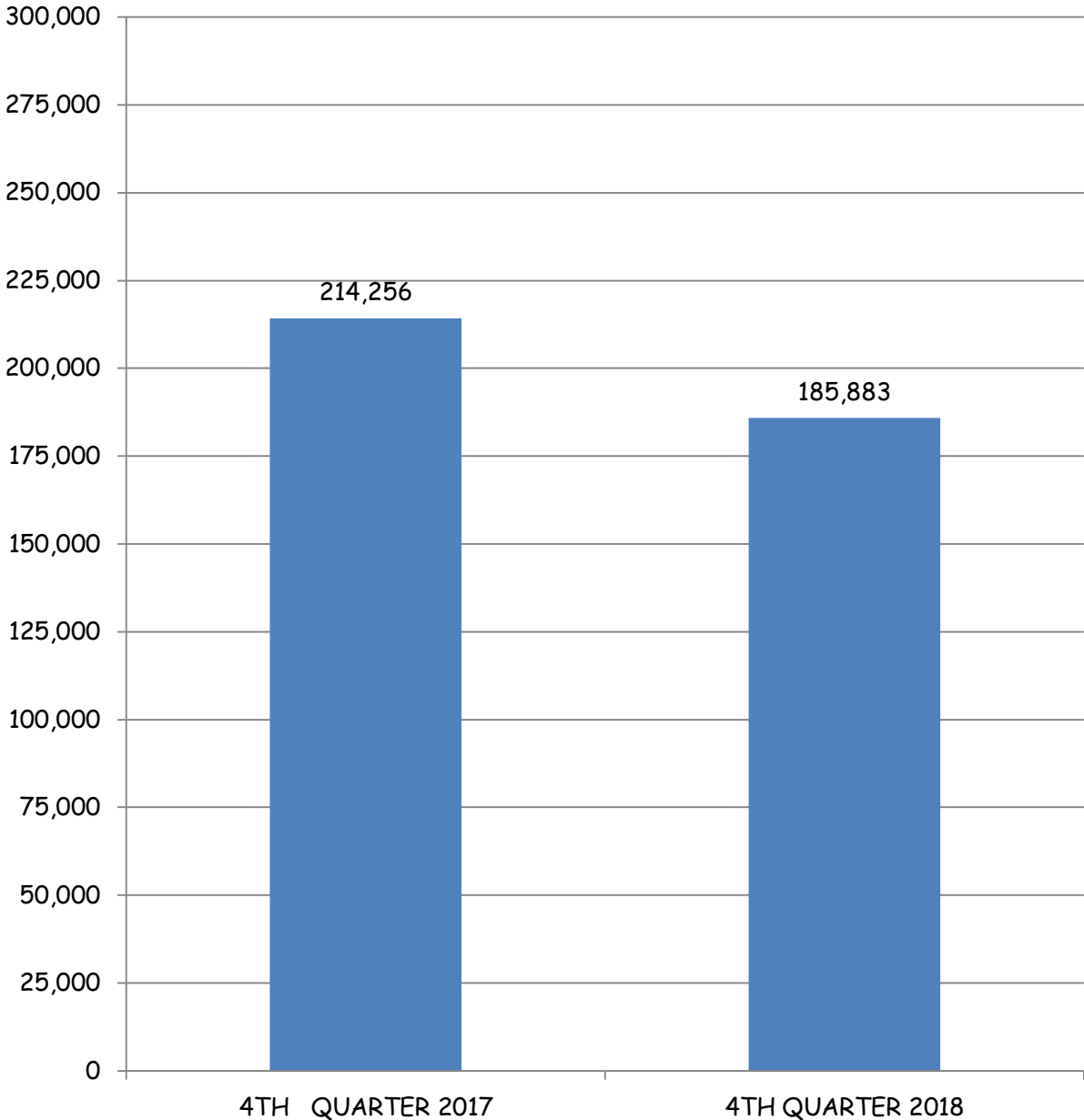

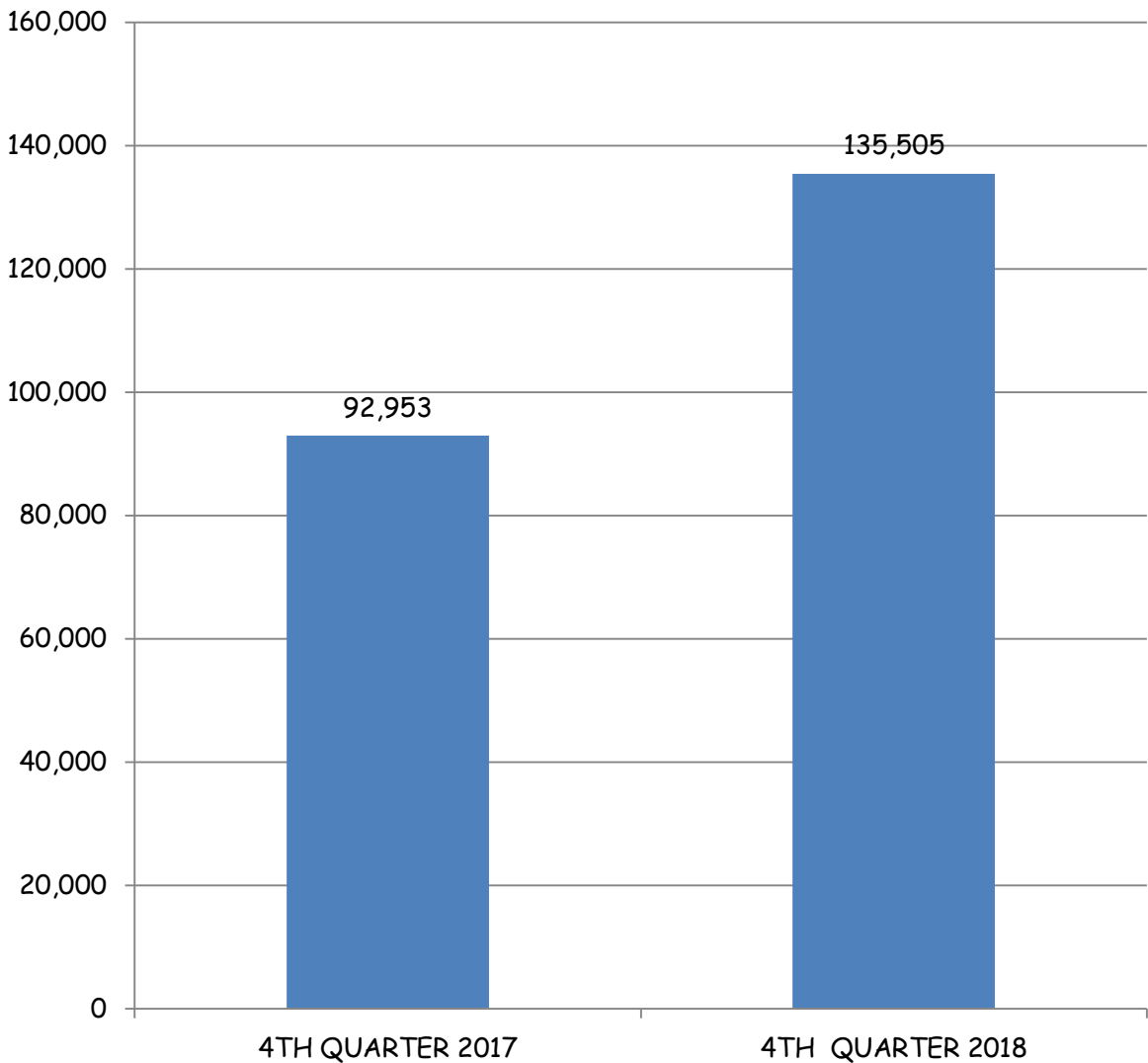

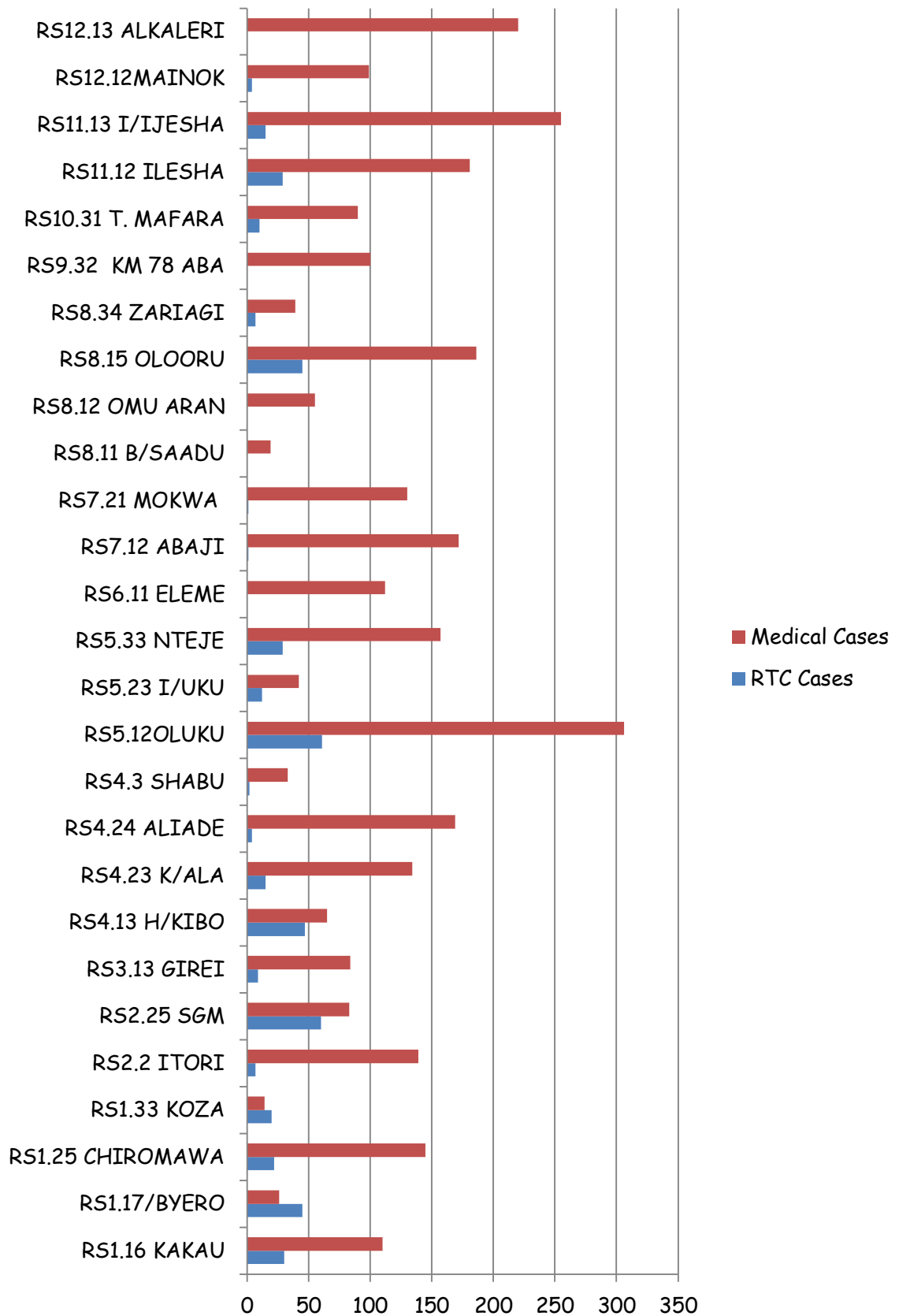

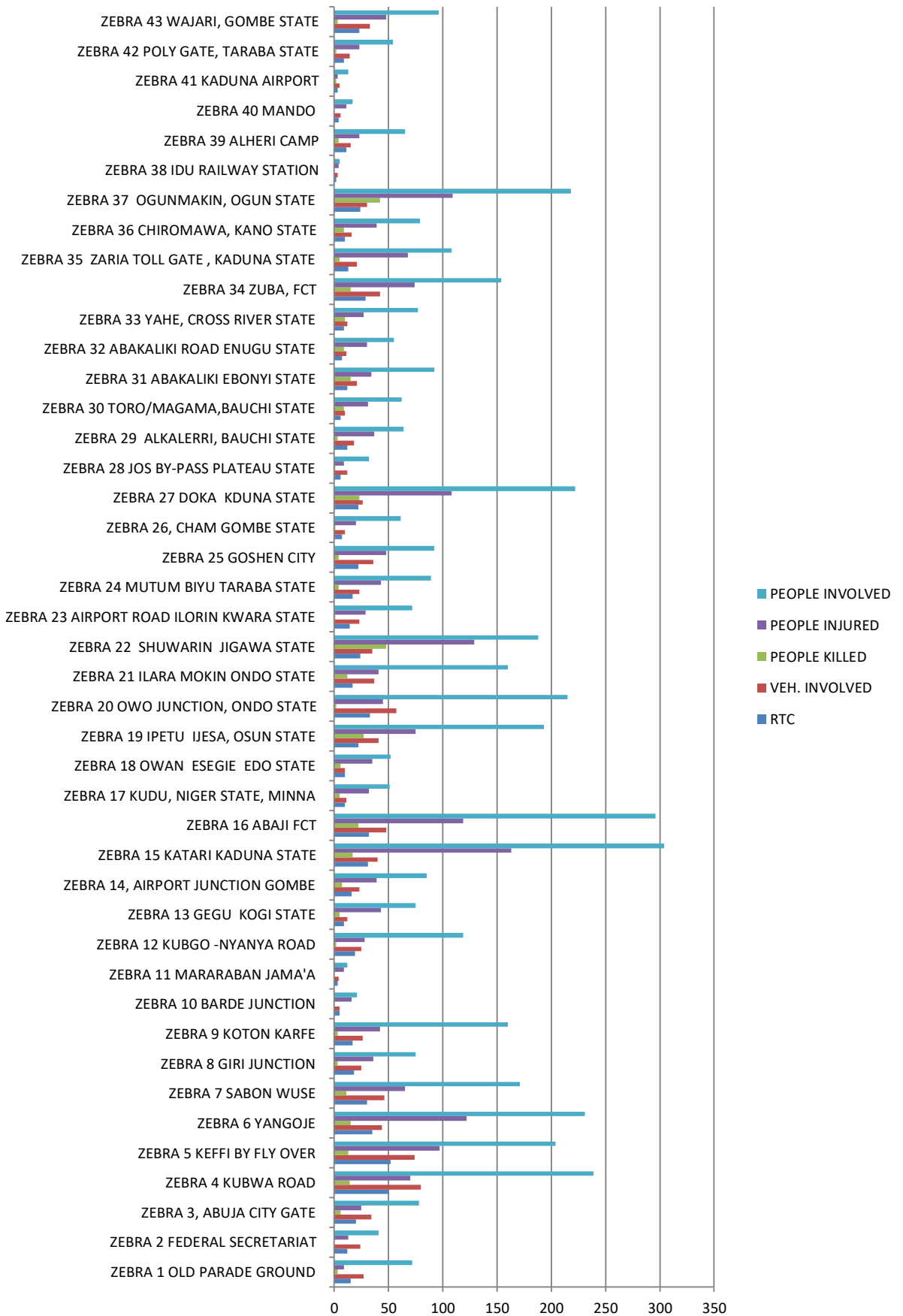
**Chart 11: RTC Cases and Medical Cases Chart illustrating Summary of Patients Attended to**

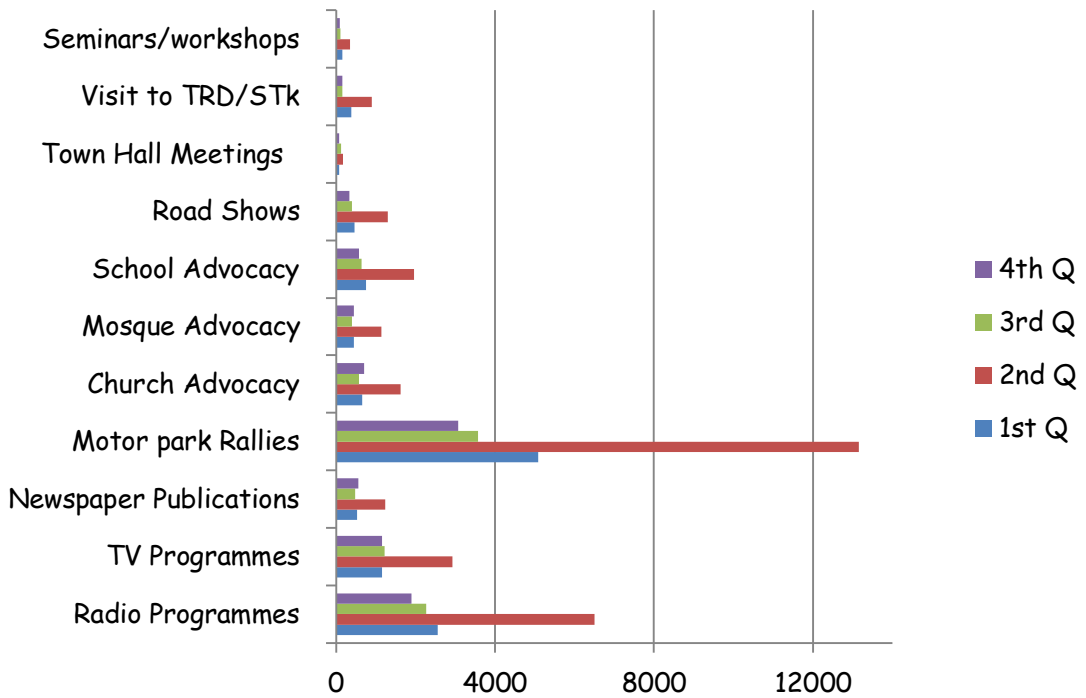

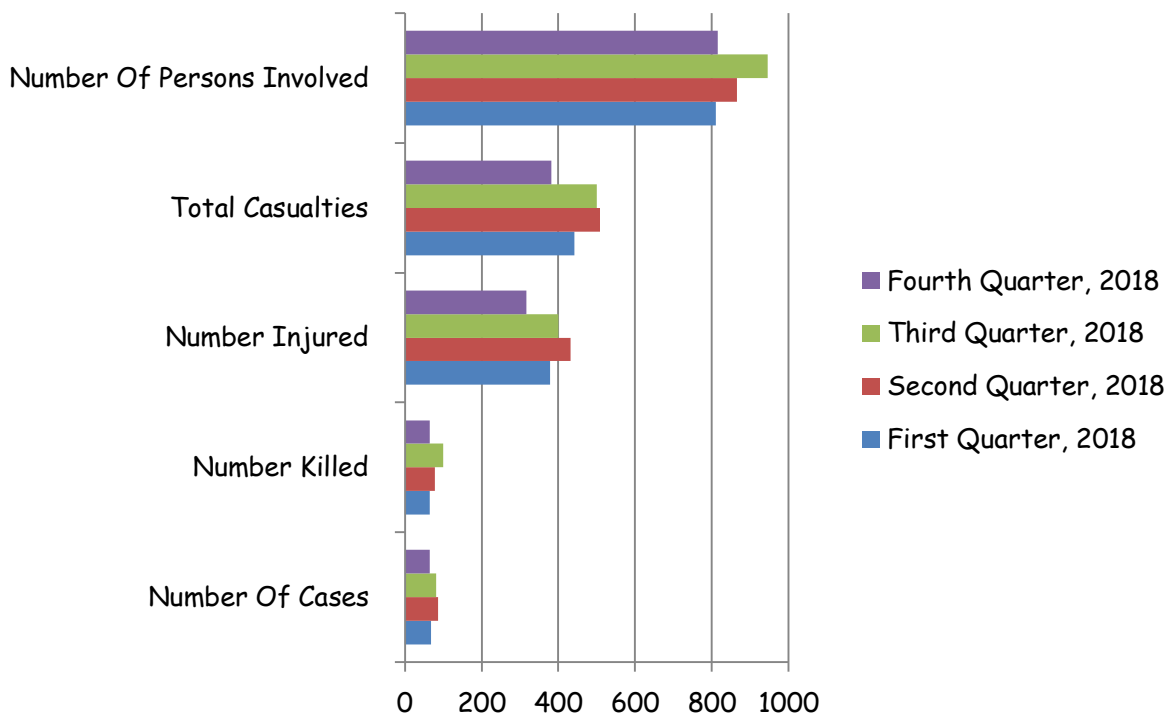

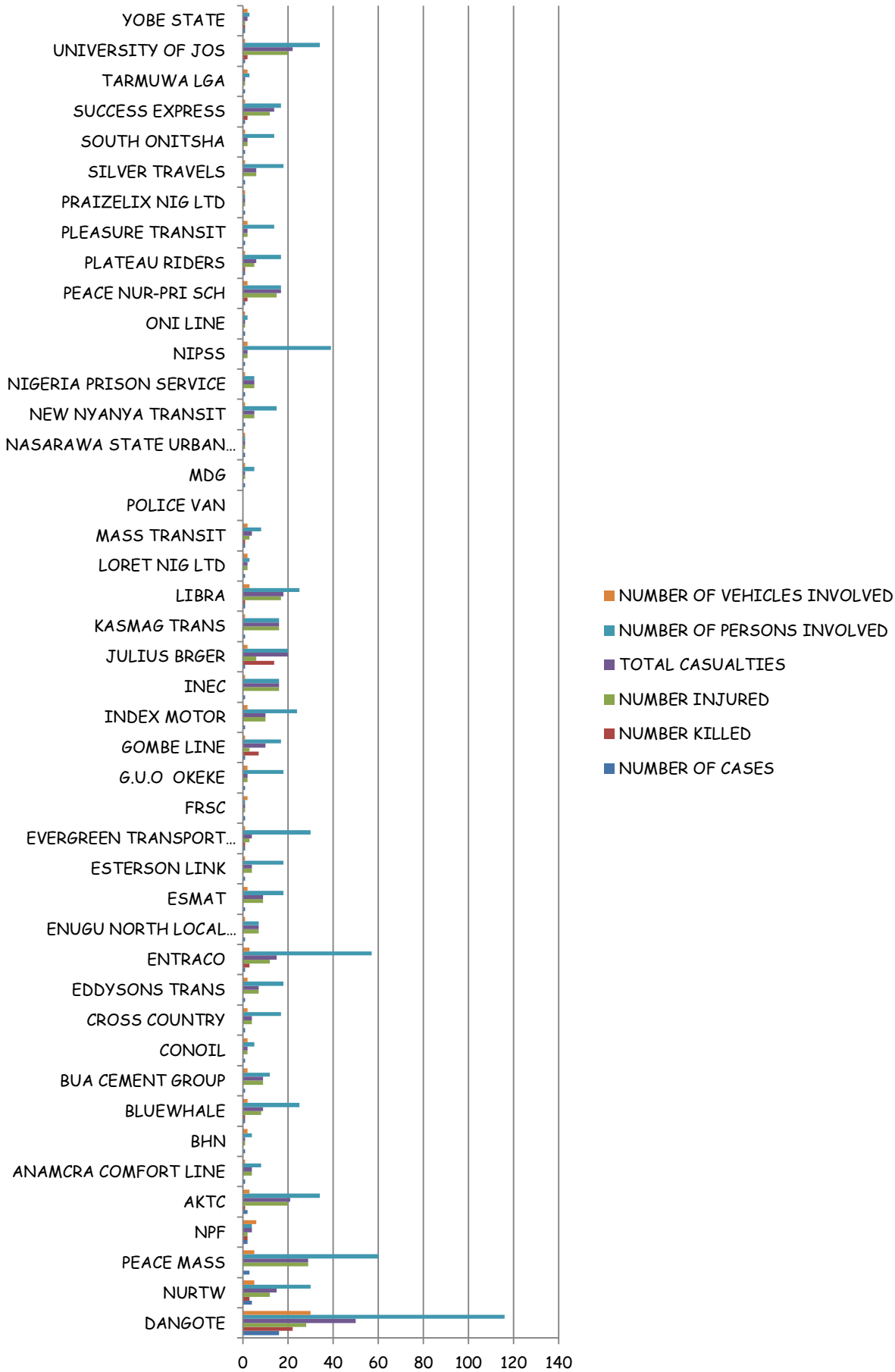
**Chart 14: Comparative Summary Of RTC Involving Fleet Operators**

**Chart 15: Summary Of RTC Involving Fleet Operators**



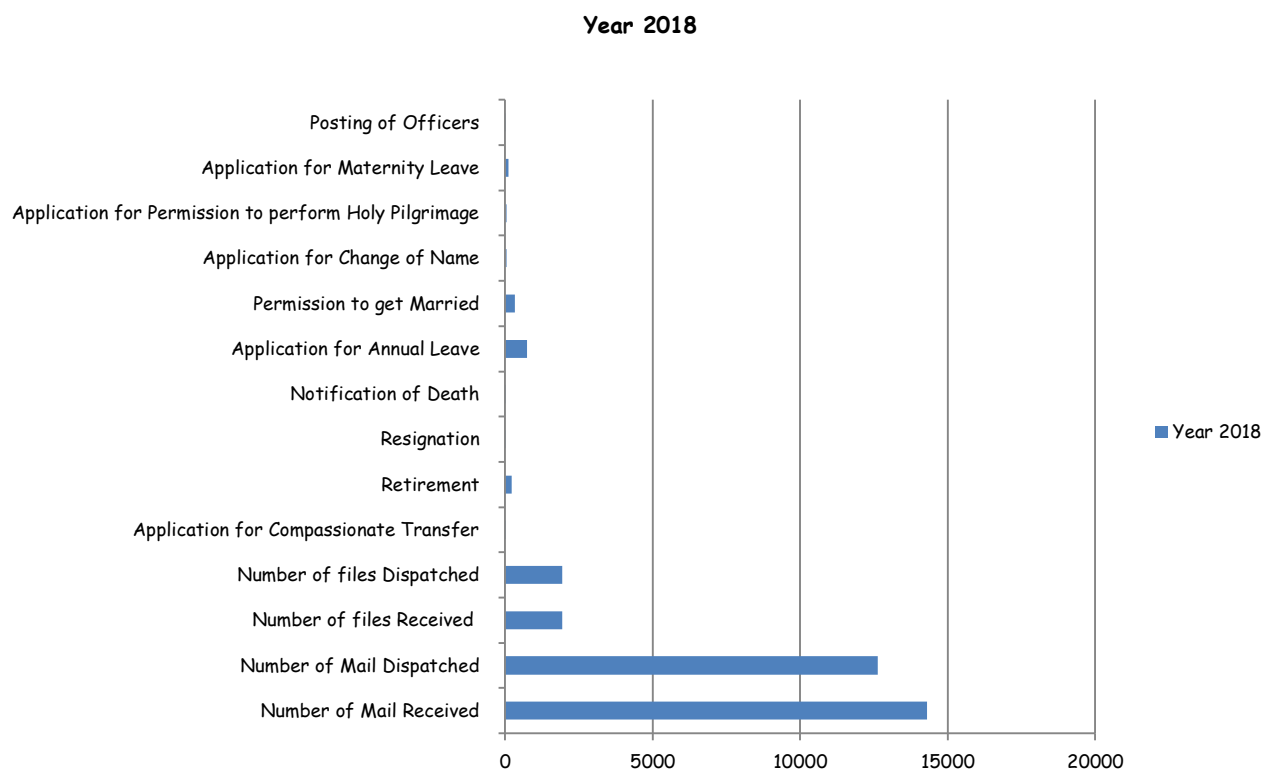

**Chart 16: Corps Secretary Activities**

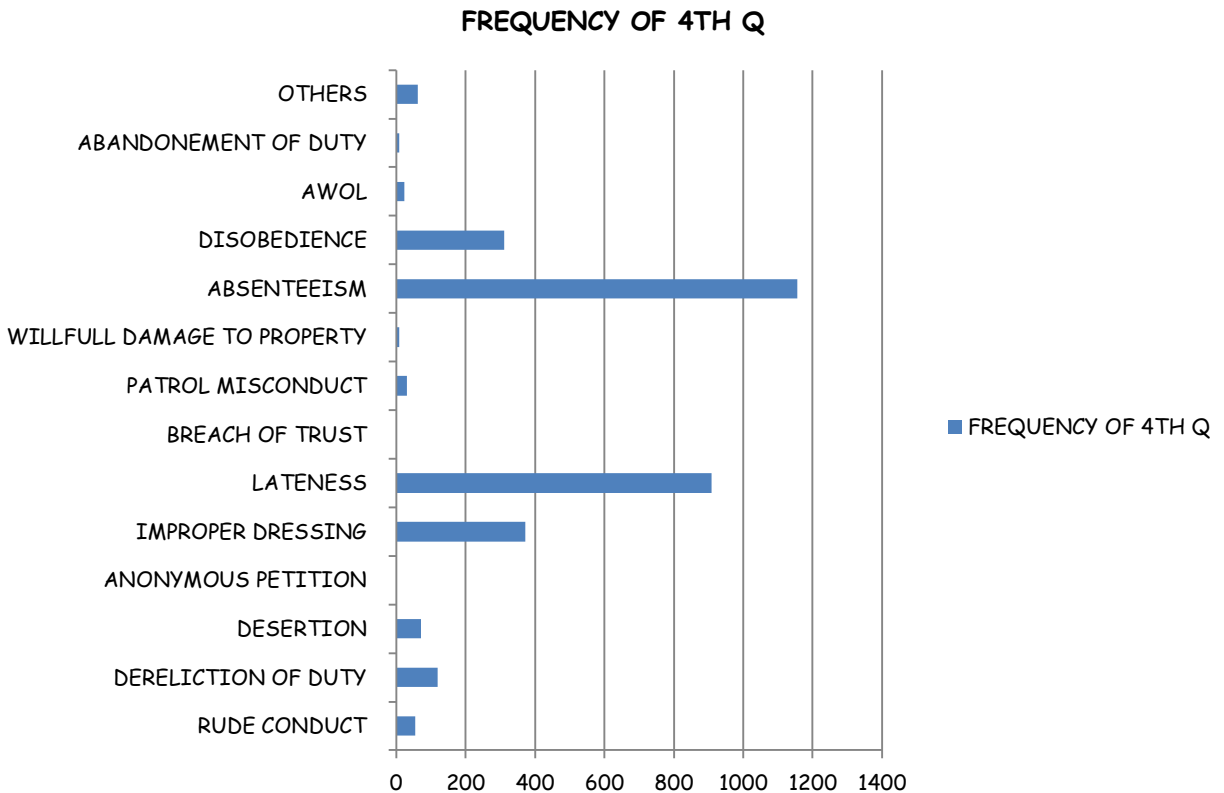

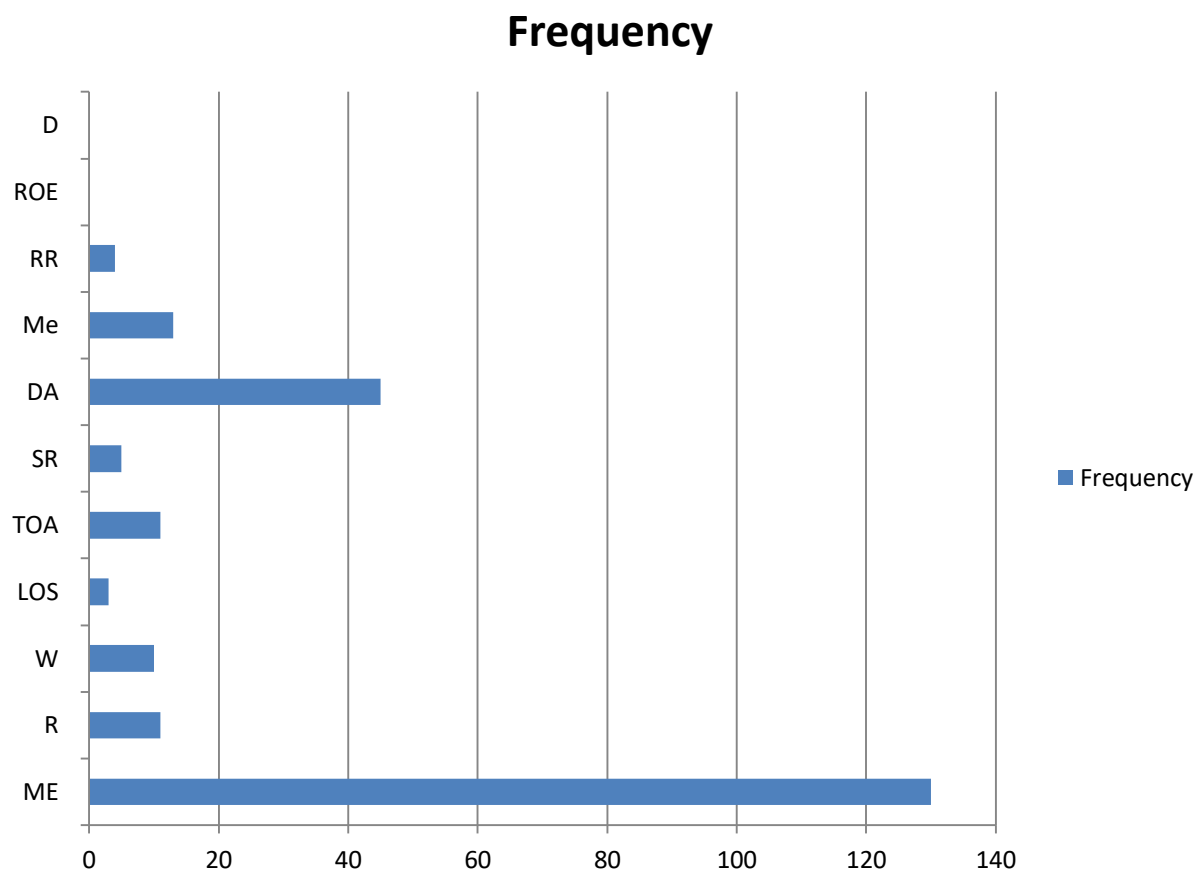

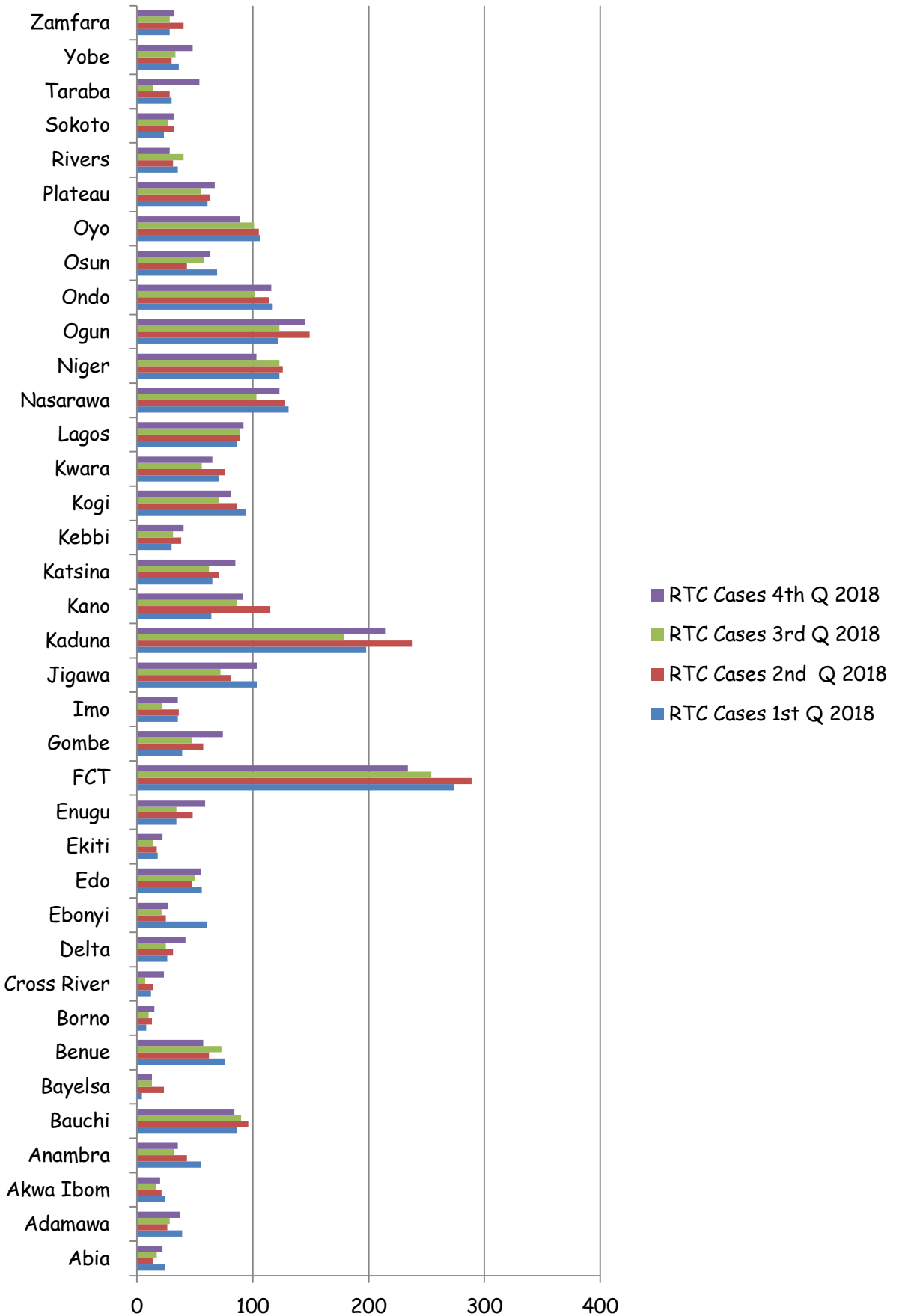

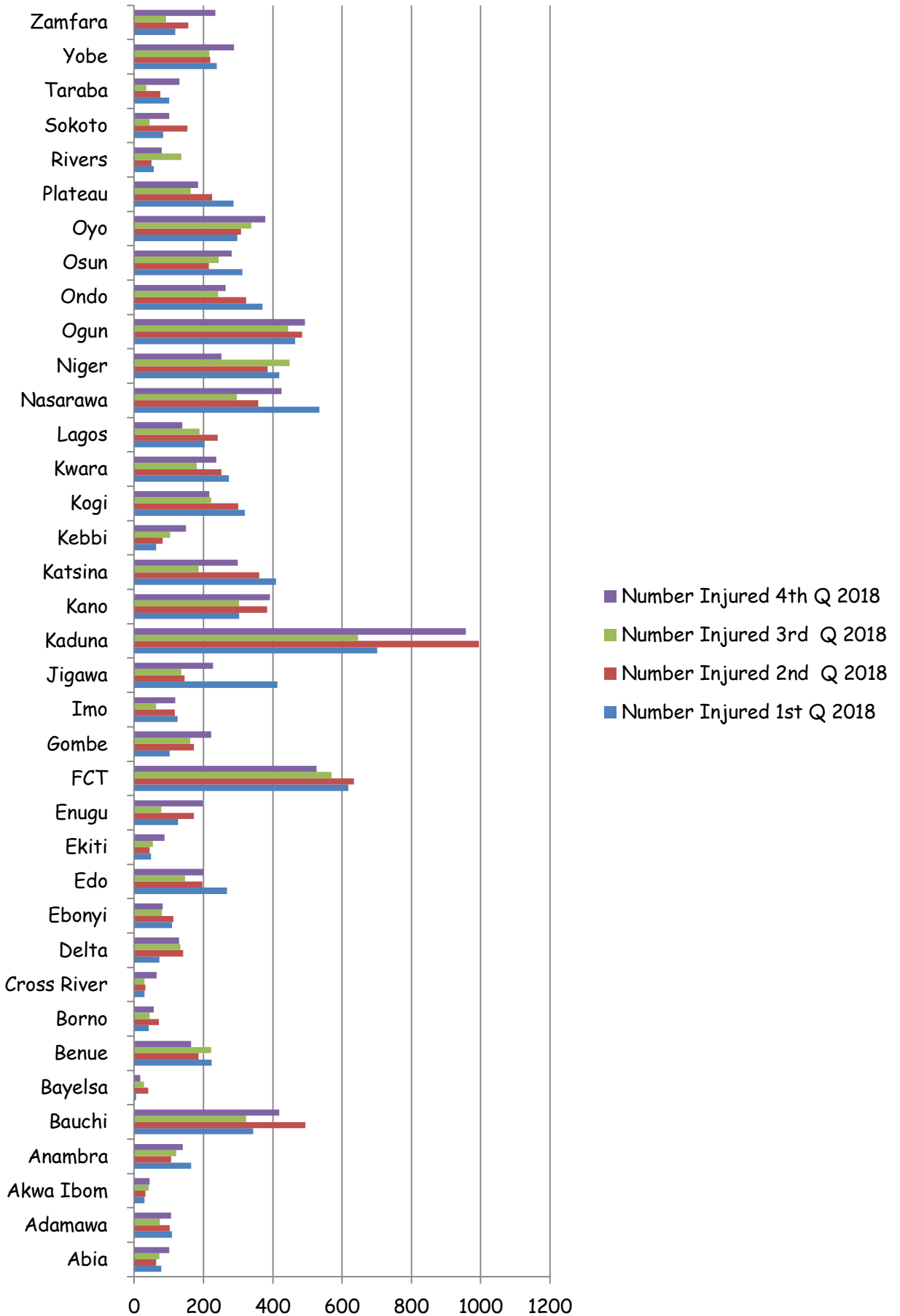
**Chart 19: RTC Cases on State Basis**

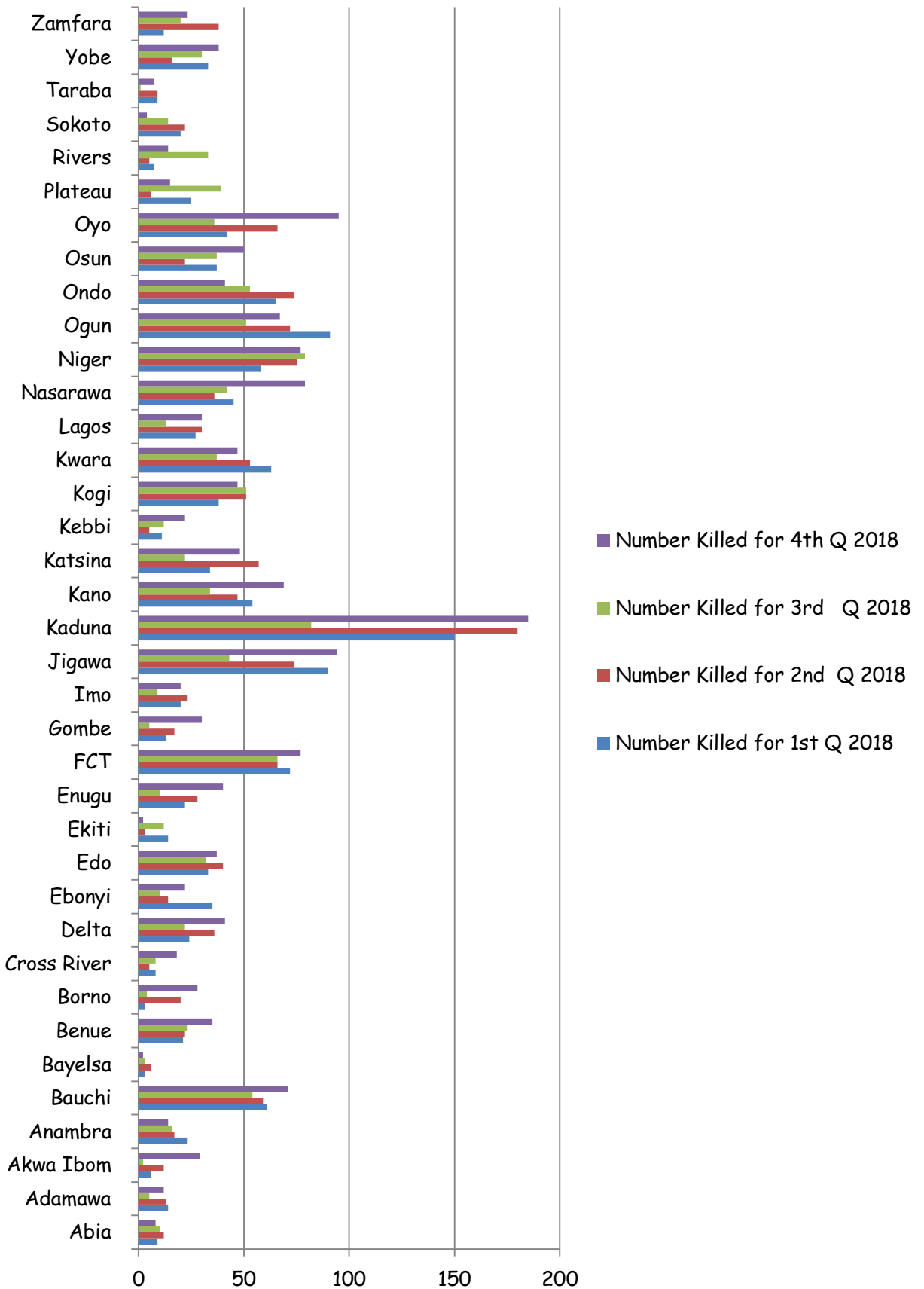
**Chart 20: Number Injured**

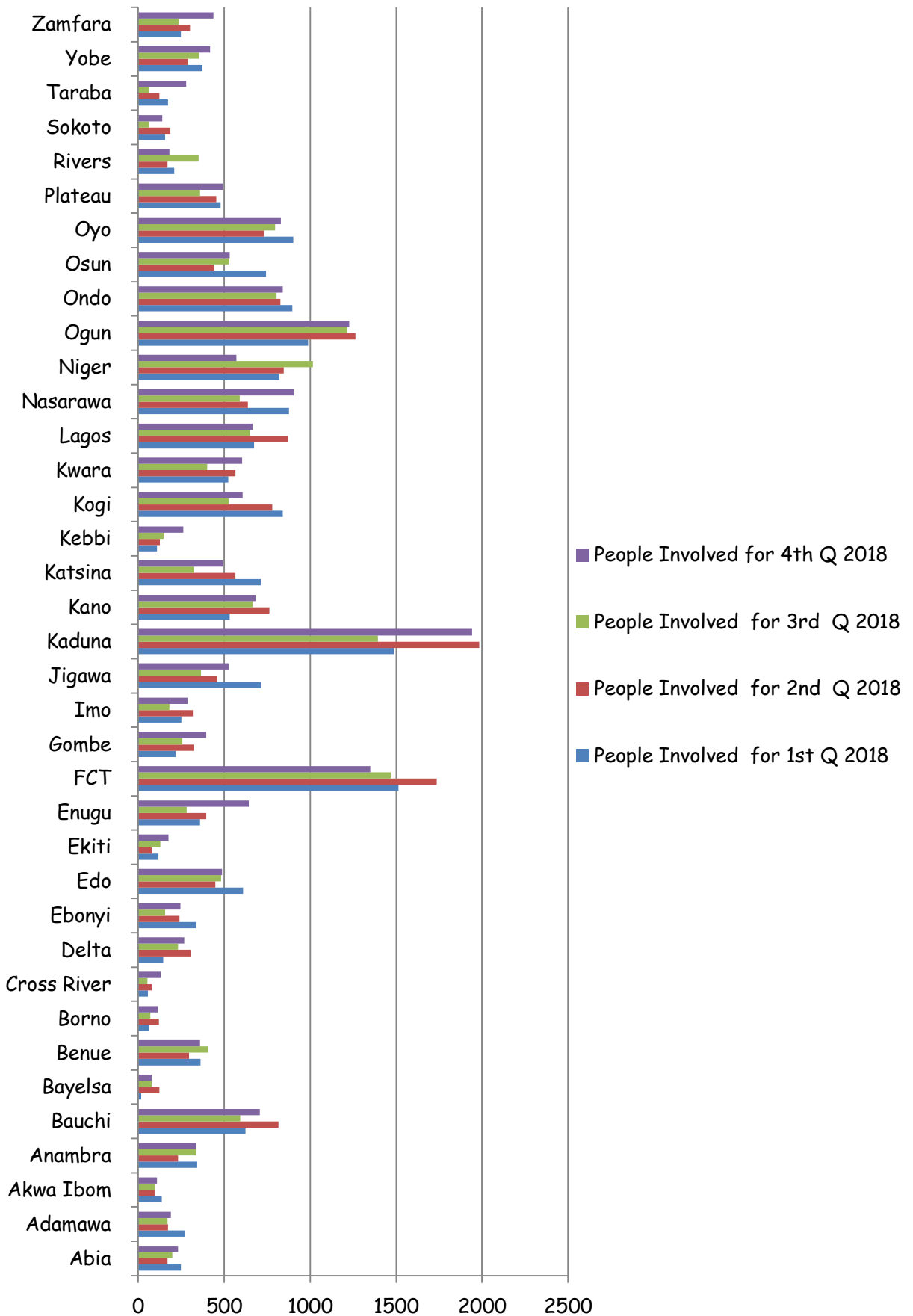
**Chart 21: Number Killed on State Basis**

**Chart 22: People Involved on State Basis**

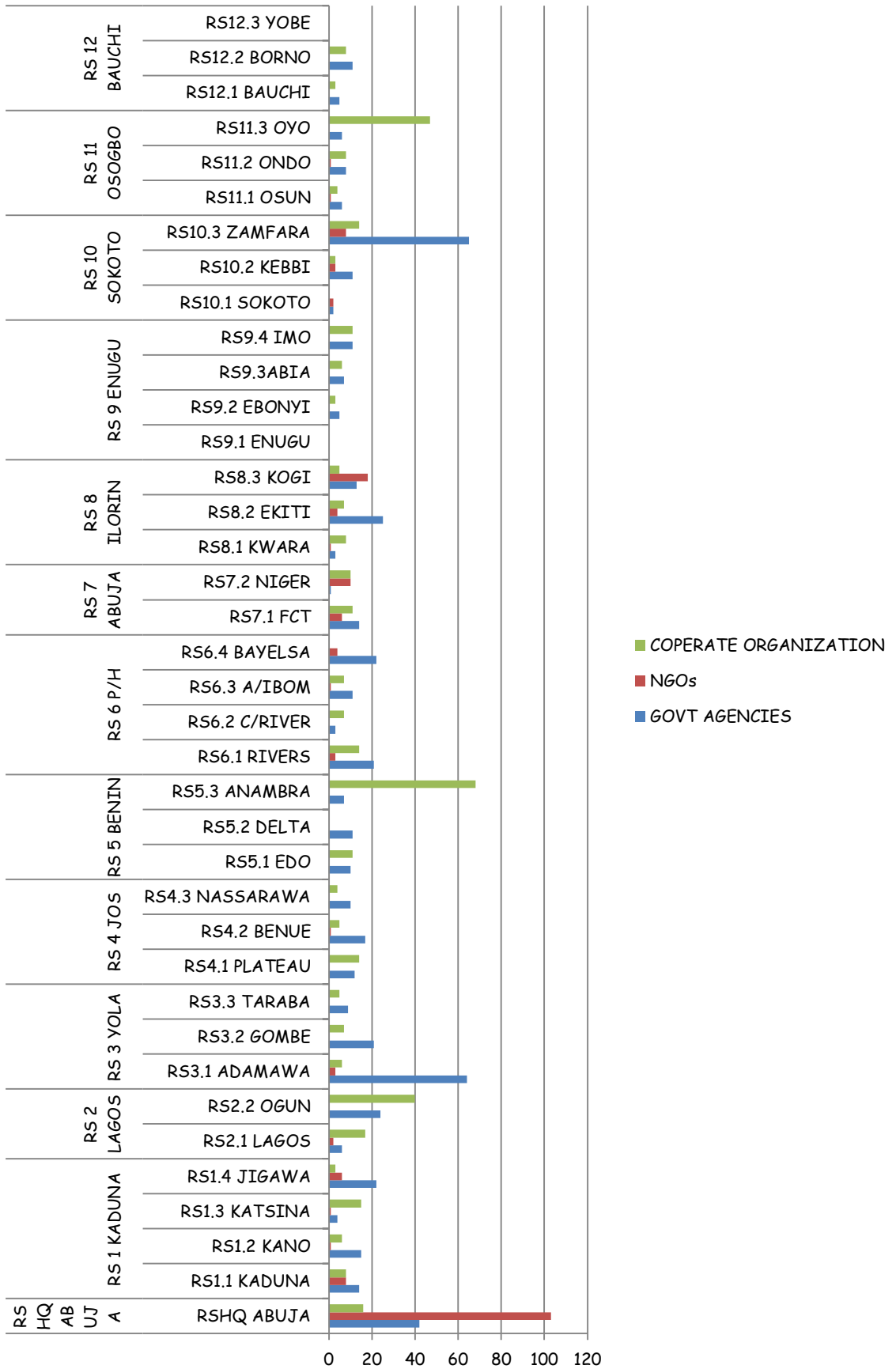

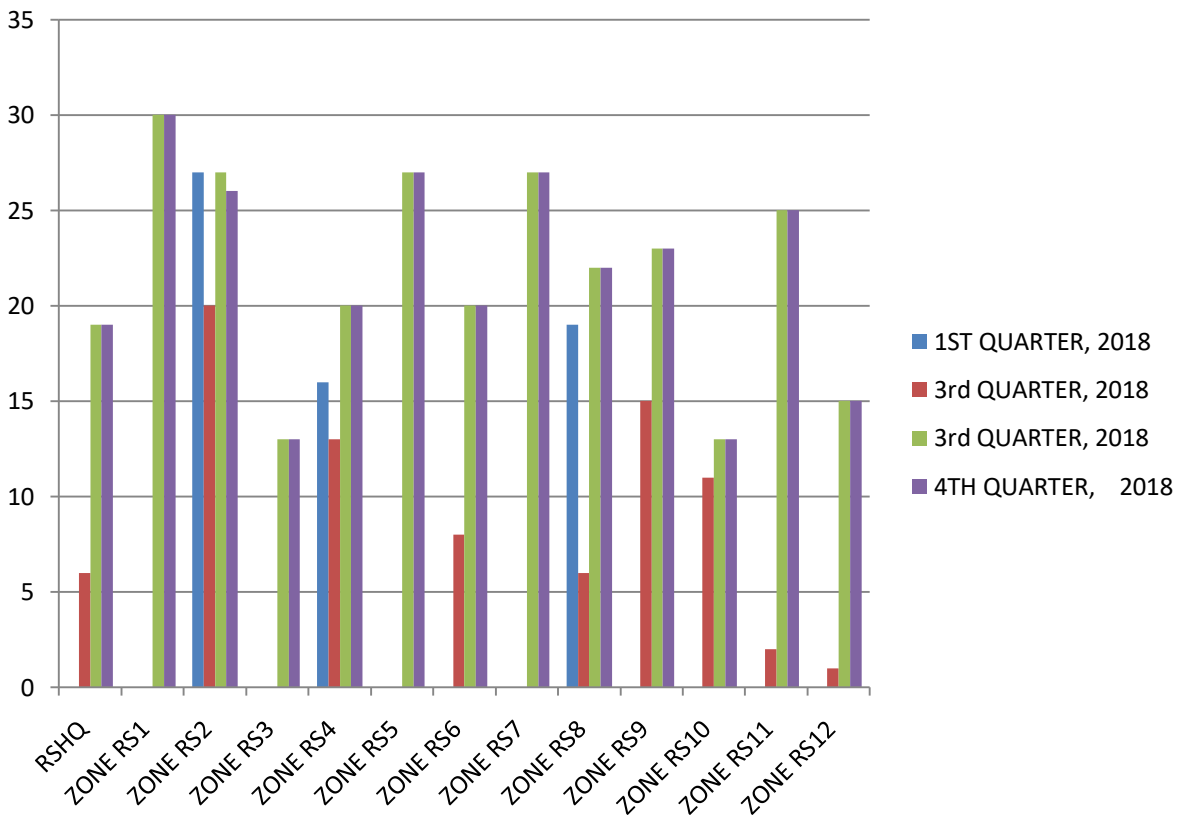
**Chart 23: Partnership Analysis of Government Agencies and NGO**

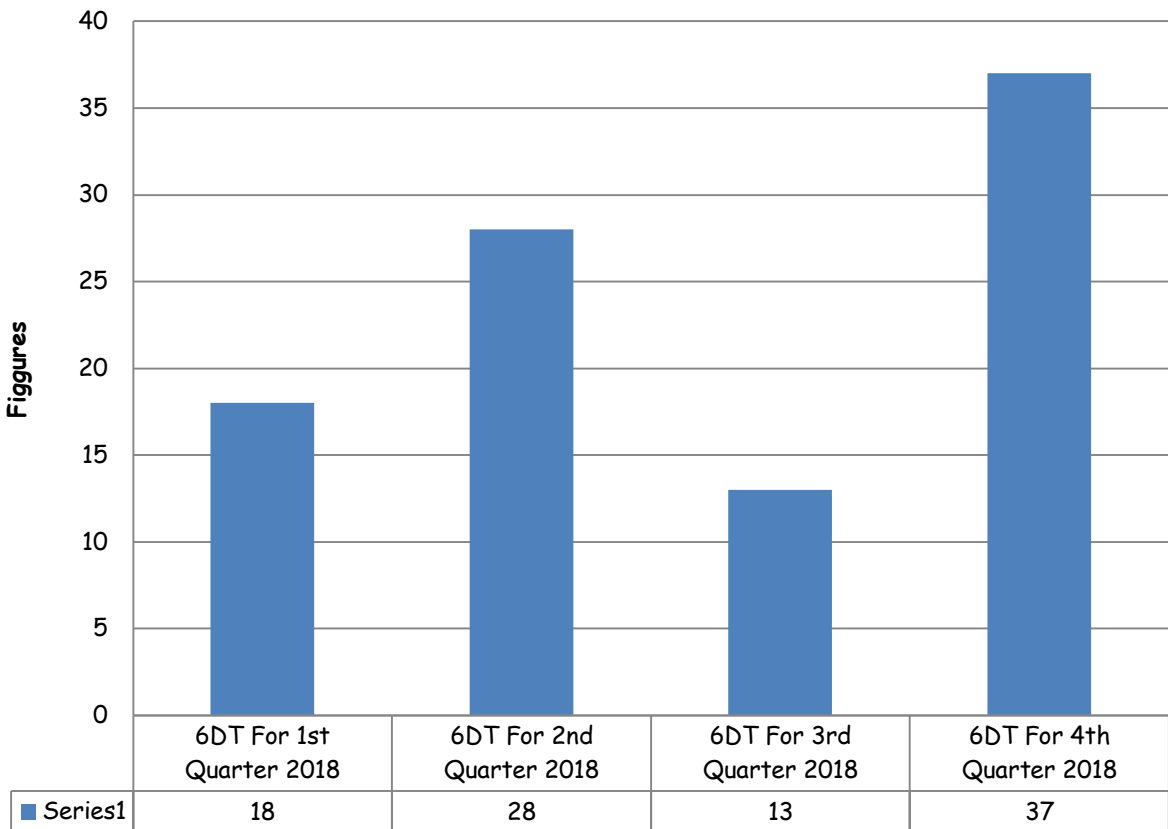
