# Edictor's Saicte

#### NATIONAL CRASH INFORMATION SYSTEM (NACRIS)

Before now, it was observed that there was a wide disparity in the police, FRSC and Hospital traffic crash data in Nigeria. So in a bid to harmonise and validate these data and based on the recommendation of World Health Organization (WHO) and United Nations (UN) for a unified data collection system on Road Traffic Crashes in Nigeria, a National and State committee on Crash Information System were constituted and chaired by the then Honourable Minister of Health, Prof C O Onyebuchi Chukwu on the 8<sup>th</sup> April, 2014. The National Committee was inaugurated for road traffic crash data collation, review, authentication, harmonization and publication in Nigeria. The FRSC was appointed as the secretary and member of these committees.

The terms of reference for the National Committee were to; collect the summary of RTC data from States through the Commissioner of Health of each State, meet quarterly to review the RTC data from the States, review all the collected RTC data and harmonize any differences, publish the authenticated National RTC data for use, ensure collaboration and co-operation among all stakeholders in data collection, streamline RTC data collection among relevant agencies and ensure all data collecting agencies including hospitals use the FRSC portal for inputting of RTC data.

Members are drawn from the Ministry of Health, Nigeria Police Force, National Emergency Management Agency, Directorate of State Security, National Population Commission, Nigeria Institute of Transport Technology, Ministry of Transportation, National Bureau of Statistics, UN Decade of Action, Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps, Federal Fire Service, World Bank Organization, the Nigerian Armed Forces, Directorate of Road Traffic Service (VIO) and the FRSC.

The Committee has consistently met to harmonize the RTC data in the country. In 2017, the Committee commenced the usage of the National Road Traffic Crash Data Management System (NRTCDMS) crash report form designed in collaboration with other Stakeholders (NACRIS members) by Mr. Bo Yttergren, a World Bank Consultant. The next phase of implementation of the NRTCDMS which will include software supplies among others is still awaiting the World Bank endorsement.

It is against this backdrop that a template for Road Traffic Crash data Collection (National Crash Data Form) in Nigeria was designed.

Chart 1: Chart Illustrating War on Critical Offences







Chart 4: Chart Illustrating Disciplinary Cases Treated





Chart 6: Incoming Requests for Variation of Staff Salaries (Marshals)




Chart 7: Summary of Transfer Allowances Activities





Chart 9: RTC Cases Chart illustrating Summary of Patients Attended to












Chart 14: Summary Of RTC Involving Fleet Operators









Chart 19: RTC Cases on State Basis




Chart 21: Number Killed on State Basis








Chart 23: Activities of NCPCCI for Q2






