ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION FOR CONVERSION COURSE OF STAFF AFFECTED BY HARMONIZATION OF RANKS OF HND HOLDERS IN THE CORPS

The above subject refers.

- 2. Management has approved the training of Staff affected by the harmonization policy of HND holders in the Corps.
- 3. Sequel to the above, two (2) weeks intensive conversion training programme has been approved to be conducted in three (3) batches for the affected Staff who are expected to report according to their respective batches.
- 4. The Training programme has been scheduled to hold as follows:

a. Batch A

Venue: FRSC Academy, Udi Arrival: Sun 28 March, 2021 Departure: Sat 10 April, 2021

b. Batch B

Venue: FRSC Academy, Udi Arrival: Sun 11 April, 2021 Departure: Sat 24 April, 2021

c. Batch C

Venue: FRSC Academy, Udi Arrival: Sun 25 April, 2021 Departure: Sat 8 May, 2021

- 5. All participants are required to undergo COVID-19 screening on arrival before documentation exercise.

- d. Writing materials
- e. Pocket sized hand sanitizer
- f. Nose masks
- g. White shorts (2)
- h. White round neck T-shirt (2) (non-patterned)
- i. White long sleeve shirt (1) (non-patterned)
- j. Black bow tie (1)
- 8. All participants are advised to be security conscious and avoid travelling in groups or disclosing details of their itinerary to forestall negative consequences.
- 9. The Commandant, FRSC Academy is hereby directed to commence immediate preparations towards receiving the participants for a successful training programme.
