You may recall that the Promotion Management Committee has sent circulars via references A and B and subsequently released the 2021 Promotable List Marshals.

- 2. Although the updating is ongoing, the Department of AHR has, surprisingly, observed an upsurge in the number of drivers and riders listed for the 2021 Promotion Exercise. If the continual complaints of Commanding Officers on inadequate drivers/riders in their commands are anything to go by, then the list is over representative of drivers and riders.
- 3. In view of the foregoing, heads of formations are, by this memo, directed to unfailingly issue letters of attestations to the drivers/riders that are coming for the promotion screening/examination with their schedule for the past one year, and the registration no of vehicles the driver/riders drive.
- 4. They must also come with their driver's license or trade test as the case may be. Any driver/rider without attestation letter will not be attended to.
- 5. COs should be bold enough to state if a Marshal claiming to be a driver/rider has not been driving. However, any false declaration will attract severe sanction.

6. Action addresses are to bring the content of this letter to the notice of all affected staff under their purview.
