Sequel to approval granted by the Secretary to the Government of the Federation for the commencement of 2024 Promotion Exercise vide quoted reference 'B', the CM has ratified the activation of the process in line with FRSC Promotion Policy 2022 (Revised).

 - b. Comprehensive Medical Fitness Test: Participants are expected to complete their comprehensive medical fitness test on Wed 14 Aug 2024 latest 1800hrs compulsorily at the FRSC Medical Centre, Gwarinpa. Failure to comply with this will lead to disqualification from the process.
 - c. Oral Interview: The Oral Interview will commence by 0900hrs on Thurs 15 Aug 2024.
 - d. <u>Departure</u>: All participants are expected to depart to their respective Commands on Fri, 16 Aug 2024.
 - e. The Dress Code for the Exercise is **Dress No 4 with Beret while the** Dress Code for Documentation is Mufti with Staff Identity Card conspicuously displayed.
