Time: 0600hrs

Dress code: FRSC (Blue or White T-Shirt) with the corresponding face cap on a sport trouser and canvass shoe (Stock available in FRSC Staff Co-operative Shop).

2. In view of the need to have a befitting and memorable outing, the following administrative instructions apply: -

a. Departments and Corps offices are required to perform their assigned duties during the exercise optimally for a successful conduct of the exercise as disorderliness or any other act of indiscipline will not be condoned.

b. Supervising Officers to mobilize all staff under their supervision to turn out for the exercise as absenteeism will not be tolerated.

c. Staff are to form up in rolls of threes (3) behind the assigned respective instructors/Motivators by 05.50hrs for Corps Marshal's opening remarks and the exercise proper.

d. FRSC Regimental Band is to form up behind the CM, Management Team Members and Special Guests.

- f. All staff are expected to comport themselves in an orderly manner and follow the lead of the Walk Instructors/Motivators. Disorderliness will not be tolerated.
- g. DCM (TSD), to provide staff buses to convey staff from the designated spots at Suleja, Kubwa, Nyanya, Kuje and Masaka axis.
- h. ACM (OPS) to deploy patrol vehicles, bikes and men for traffic control along the designated routes.
- i. ACM (Corps Public Education Officer) to ensure adequate publicity and anchor the programme as appropriate.
- j. The CC (Corps Intelligence Officer) and CC (Corps Provost), to take charge of discipline, security and crowd control.
- k. The CC (Corps Medical and Rescue Services) to provide Ambulances and Medical personnel.
- l. Sector Commander, RS7.1 FCT to provide additional patrol vehicles and deploy adequate men for traffic control along the designated routes.
- m. Departments and Corps offices' Admin Officers are to ensure that all staff present for the event put their names and signature in the Attendance Registers.
